

Privacy Statement

General

The GSPP Foundation attaches great importance to the protection of your personal data. In this Privacy Statement we want to provide clear and transparent information about how we handle personal data.

We do everything we can to guarantee your privacy and therefore handle personal data with care. The GSPP Foundation complies in all cases with applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation. In any case, this means the following:

- your personal data is processed in accordance with the purpose for which it was provided; these goals and type of personal data are described in the Privacy Statement;
- processing of your personal data is limited to only those data that are at least necessary for the purposes for which they are processed;
- we ask for your explicit permission if we need it for the processing of your personal data;
- we have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data;
- we do not pass on personal data to other parties, unless this is necessary for the execution of the purposes for which they were provided;
- we are aware of your rights regarding your personal data, we would like to point this out to you and we will respect it.

As GSPP Foundation we are responsible for the processing of your personal data. If, after reading our Privacy Statement, or in a more general sense, you have questions or wish to contact us, you can do this via the contact details at the bottom of this document.

Processing of personal data of association members

Personal data of participants are processed by STICHTING GSPP for the following objective (s):

- administrative purposes;
- communication with members;
- implementing GSPP accreditation.

The basis for this personal data is the GSPP accreditation.

For the above objectives, the GSPP Foundation may request the following personal data from you:

- name;
- address data;
- phone number;
- e-mail address;
- relevant profile information.

Your personal data is stored by the GSPP Foundation for the above processing during the term of accreditation and thereafter only in the (financial) administration on the basis of legal requirements.

Processing of suppliers' personal data

Personal data of suppliers are processed by STICHTING GSPP for the following objective (s):

- administrative purposes;
- communication about an assignment
- executing or issuing an assignment.

The basis for this personal data is the agreed assignment.

For the above objectives, the GSPP Foundation may request the following personal data from you:

- name;
- address data
- phone number;
- e-mail address;
- relevant profile information.

Your personal data is stored by the GSPP Foundation for the above processing (s) during the term of an agreement and thereafter only in the financial administration on the basis of legal requirements.

Processing of personal data of prospects, stakeholders, lobby contacts or interested parties

Personal data of prospects, stakeholders, lobby contacts or interested parties are processed by the GSPP Foundation for the provision of information (digital and paper) and / or targeted contacts.

The basis for this personal data is verbal permission, issuing a business card and / or via a link on LinkedIn or other internet medium and / or e-mail contact.

For the above purpose, the GSPP Foundation may request the following personal data from you:

- name;
- address data;
- phone number;
- e-mail address.

Your personal data is stored by the GSPP Foundation for the above processing for the period in which one is seen as a prospect, stakeholder / lobby contact and / or interested party.

Provision to third parties

We can provide the data you provide to us to third parties if this is necessary for the implementation of the purposes described above.

For example, we use a third party for:

- taking care of the IT systems and the internet environment;
- taking care of the (financial) administration.

We never pass on personal data to other parties with whom we have not concluded a processor agreement. We will of course make the necessary agreements with these parties (processors) to guarantee the security of your personal data. Furthermore, we will not provide the information you provide to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted. An example of this is that the police requests (personal) data from us in the context of an investigation. In such a case, we must cooperate and are therefore obliged to provide this information. We can also share personal data with third parties if you give us written permission for this.

Within the EU

We do not provide personal data to parties located outside the EU.

Minors

We only process personal data of minors (persons under the age of 16) if written permission has been given by the parent, caregiver or legal representative.

Retention period

STICHTING GSPP does not store personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided or required by law. Ex-accredited companies are listed as terminated in the system. Their data will remain inactive for control purposes.

Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unlawful processing, for example we have taken the following measures;

- all persons who can access your data on behalf of the GSPP Foundation are bound by confidentiality;
- we have a username and password policy on all our systems;
- we anonymize and ensure the encryption of personal data if there is reason to do so;
- we make backups of the personal data in order to be able to restore them in the event of physical or technical incidents;
- we regularly test and evaluate our measures;
- our employees have been informed about the importance of protecting personal data.

Rights regarding your data

You have the right to inspect, rectify or delete the personal data that we have received from you. You can also object to the processing of your personal data (or part thereof) by us or by one of our processors. You also have the right to have the data provided by you transferred by us to yourself or, on your instructions, directly to another party. We may ask you to identify yourself before we can respond to the aforementioned requests.

If we process your personal data on the basis of a permission given by you, you always have the right to withdraw this permission.

Complaints

If you have a complaint about the processing of your personal data, we ask you to contact us directly. If we cannot work it out with you, we will of course find this very unfortunate. You always have the right to file a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority, which is the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
